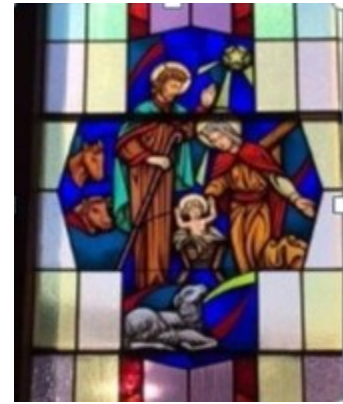

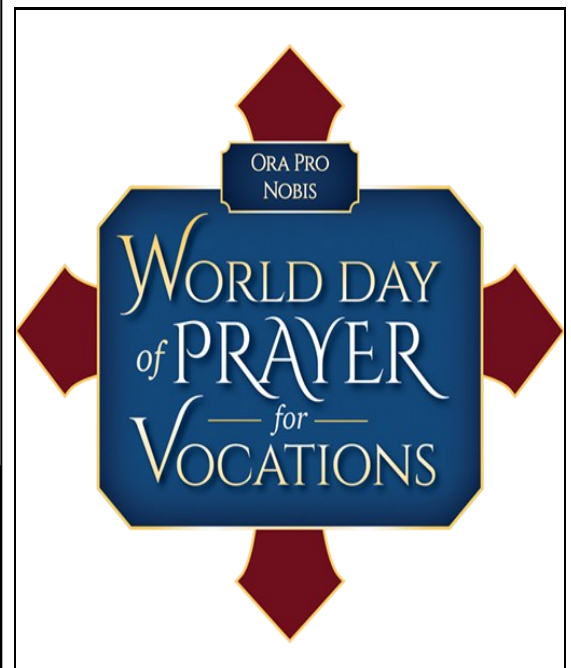

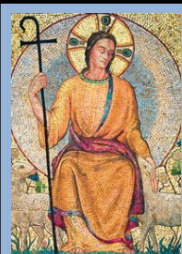


New Hampshire Catholic Appeal

We look forward to resuming in the Fall.

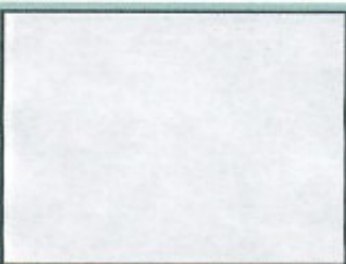
SACRED HEART FOOD PANTRY—120 Club
