Parish Gathering to welcome our New Pastor

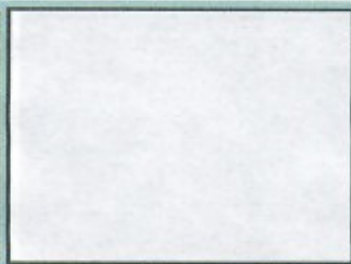
